Astonishing quotes shared by the students

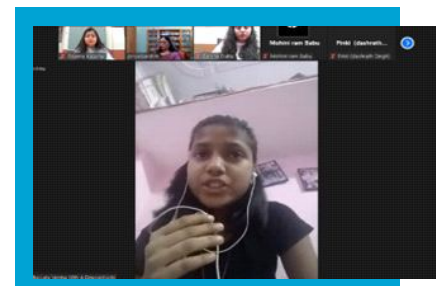
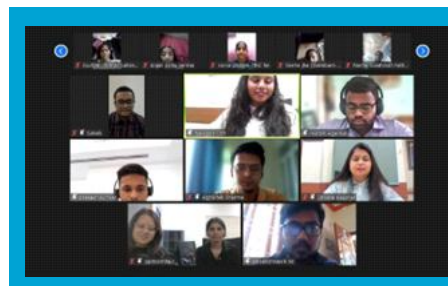
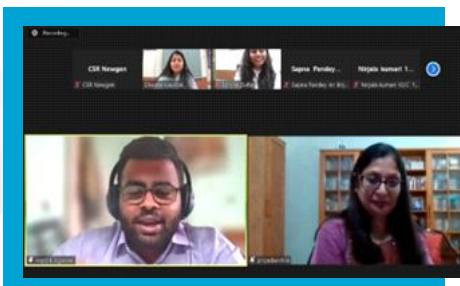
