CASE STUDY OF KRIPA, 8th Grade, TEKHAND SCHOOL

Meet Kripa, a student who has been a part of NDDP sessions since 7th grade. In an interview, she mentioned that due to COVID, she was forced to spend her entire 6th grade at home, which significantly impacted her education. When schools finally reopened, she had moved to the 7th grade and was struggling to understand her lessons. This made it difficult for her to secure good marks in her unit tests.

Kripa was introduced to the NDDP online sessions by the NDDP facilitator and became a regular attendee after receiving her tablet. The sessions covered topics like Devotional paths to the divine, Mughal Empire, Light, etc. With the help of the NDDP sessions, Kripa's grades rose to 45/60 in the 7th grade exam. Now in the 8th grade, she admits that she hasn't received low marks in any of her class tests or exams since then. Recently, in the 8th grade first term exam, she scored 56/60 marks in SST and 47/60 in science.

Now attending Tekhand school, Kripa, dreams of becoming a CBI agent. She presently resides with her parents and three siblings. Her mother is a homemaker, while her father works in a private corporation.

Kripa shares that the NDDP sessions have made a big difference for her and her family, especially her mother, who is also a part of the NDDP Mothers' sessions. She reveals how NDDP has given her mother a platform to reveal her hidden skills and has awakened the desire to achieve something within her.
